

One of the major concerns with the harsh cold is thermal shock when bathing, which claims thousands of lives every year.

The forecast indicates that even the provinces bordering the Pacific Ocean will have **minimum temperatures below zero.** This weather condition puts people at risk of **heat shock**. This is due to the sudden change in external **temperature**, which affects the body. According to the Association of Doctors, the annual average of deaths from heat shock across the country is around **14,000 victims** while in the shower. The highest numbers are in January, December and February, in that order.

How thermal shock occurs (ヒートショック/heat shock)



In general, bathrooms and toilets are on the north side of the house or apartment, which is considered a colder side. When you enter the **bathroom**, you go from a **heated room to one with a very low temperature**. This sudden contrast causes **heat shock**. Blood vessels contract to keep the heat out and **blood pressure** rises. When you immerse yourself in the hot water **of the** hot tub, your blood vessels expand and your blood pressure suddenly drops, causing it to fluctuate several times. **Blood pressure fluctuations** strain the heart and can lead to a **heart attack or stroke**.

What to do to avoid thermal shock

There's nothing more relaxing than a good bath after a day's work. But in winter, with the temperature outside very low, there are 8 essential recommendations for prevention.

- 1. The temperature of the **bath** water should be set to up to **41°C**
- 2. Before taking off your clothes, we recommend turning on the **shower and heating up the bathroom**
- 3. If you're going to get into the **hot tub**, make sure it's **no longer than 10 minutes** and preferably up to your waist.
- 4. If your shoulders feel cold, you can cover them with a towel warmed in hot water
- 5. If you have drunk alcohol, you should avoid the **hot tub.**
- 6. Never get out of the bath or **hot** tub quickly. The ideal is to get out slowly
- 7. Lay down a wooden platform or a thick rug so that your feet don't get cold from the bathroom floor.
- 8. Avoid bathing late at night when the **temperature drops even more**



After dressing normally, the recommendation is to put a sweater over your clothes or pajamas, even if you're staying indoors and moving from room to room.
