Due to the implementation of the [Plastic Resources Recycling Promotion Act], **we will collect** [plastic containers/packaging] and [plastic products] as **recyclables**.

Plastic packaging



What is plastic packaging?

Refers to plastic containers or packaging that became unnecessary after use.

*They have the plastic recycling mark. プラ



Items that **will begin** be collected as plastic products.

Plastic products



What is a plastic product?

This refers to plastic products that are not containers, packaging or PET bottles. They are not marked for recycling and used to be disposed of as burnable waste.

Items that can be placed in the collection bag (**acceptable items**)



Plastic products that can be collected must meet all of the following conditions:

- Be made of plastic only (100% plastic material)
- Have a size on each side smaller than 50cm (if necessary, they can be cut to meet this requirement)
- Have a material thickness of less than 5mm
- Be **clean** (wipe off dirt or rinse lightly).



Everyday products: hangers, toothbrushes, hairbrushes, etc.

Kitchen utensils: storage containers, lunch boxes, rice spoons, etc.

Items that can be crushed, broken or bent with light force, even if they are 5mm thick or more.
(Examples: Styrofoam trays, plastic trays, etc.)

Items that should not be placed in the collection bag (**Items not accepted**)



Objects containing materials other than plastic (rubber, metal or composite products)

Objects with a risk of fire or injury that require attention:



Device with built-in rechargeable battery



Lighters, objects with blades, etc.

Plastic + Paint
Plastic + Metal
Plastic + Fabric
Plastic + Metal + Battery
Lithium ion

Highlighter (fluorescent pen), signature pen, ballpoint pen, pencil sharpener, stapler, clothespin, dolls, glasses case, smartphone, calculator, games console, etc.

Plastic from discarded products from a commercial establishment is not considered industrial waste, therefore, it is the responsibility of the trader to ensure their correct disposal.
